Know all men by these presents, that we, Edward Evans, and Mary Evans wife of said Edward Evans, of the County of Gallia, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand, paid by Thomas Lewis, have bargained and sold, and do hereby grant bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situated in the County of Gallia, in the State of Ohio and in the Township of Claysburg and bounded and described as follows: To wit: All of the North West half of the Northwest quarter of Section Number Eighteen Township Number Six of Range Sixteen containing eighty acres more or less. (Plants entered at the Land Office of Marietta Ohio)

To have and to hold said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Edward Evans and Mary Evans, for themselves and hers, doth hereby covenant with said Thomas Lewis, his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized of the aforesaid premises aforesaid; that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrances, whatsoever and that they will forever warrant and defend the same, with the appurtenances, unto the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
