





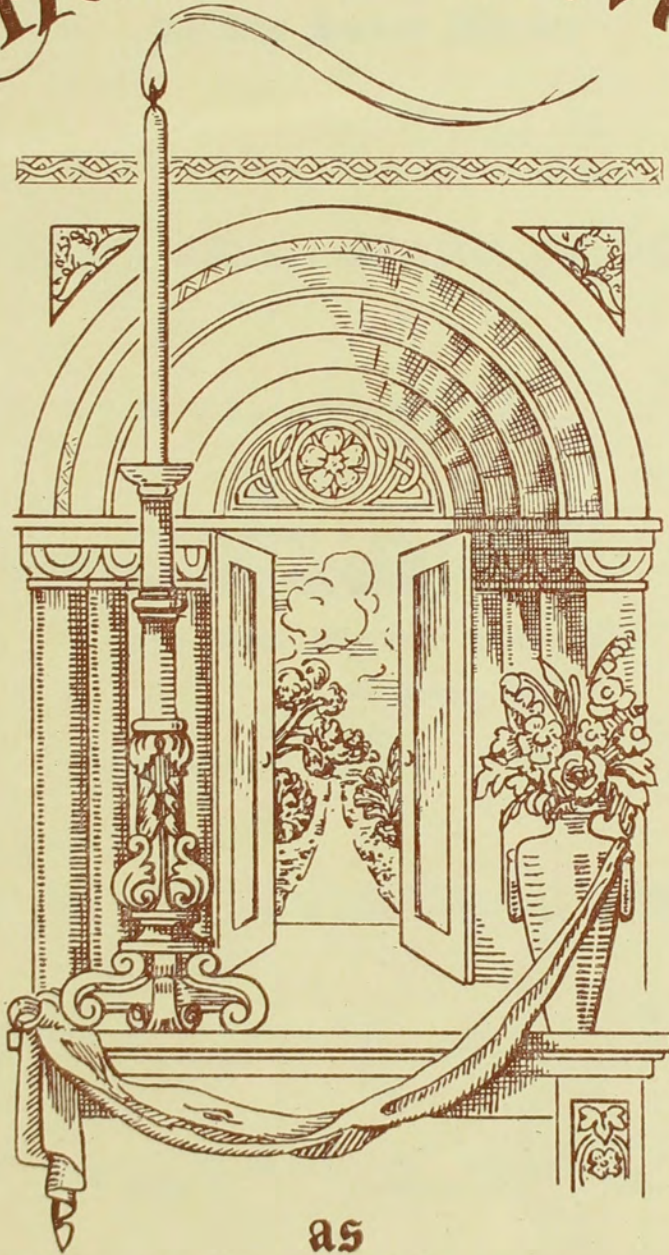
## Preface
