On consideration thereof, the court finds that notice of the hearing on said application has been dispensed with as provided by law, and the court having personally examined the appli-

cant in open court and heard the sworn testimony of Mrs. Jessie Martin and Mr. Alexander A. Martin, parents of the applicant; also examined clear and convincing documentary evidence, as follows: Honorable Discharge, U.S. Army, dated March 31, 1946, Separation Center - Camp Atterbury, Indiana, supporting date and place of birth, Birth Certificate of Thomas Stanley Martin, son of the applicant, dated January 9, 1949, filed with Ohio Department of Health, Division of Vital Statistics, Columbus, Ohio, Registrar's No. 244, Registration Dist. No. 904, supporting date and place of birth, and Insurance Policy, Lutheran Brotherhood, Minneapolis, Minnesota, dated May 23, 1950, Policy No. 293616, supporting date and place of birth;
