

Corporal Charles Peterson No.12995 12<sup>th</sup> Battalion Royal Scots Died September 25<sup>th</sup> 1915, aged 19.

Born in Perth Enlisted in Perth Killed in action

Son of Albert and Catherine Peterson, 53 Meal Vennel, Perth.

Mr Peterson, 53 Meal Vennel, Perth, has received information that his son, Corporal Charles Peterson, 12<sup>th</sup> Royal Scots, has been killed. Corporal Peterson was a young and particularly bright lad of 19 past, and answered his country's call at the outbreak of war. He was well known in football circles, being connected to Jeanfield F.C. Employed in Moncrieff Glass Works, he had the opportunity on more than one occasion of returning from the front to engage in government work, but declined. Information regarding his death has been received by letter from a comrade, between whom and the deceased an arrangement was made to communicate with their relatives in the event of one or other being wounded or killed.
